







- "You pledge as security all joint and individual deposit accounts you have now and in the future."



Rule 7004(b)(3):

• Service on business entity

- First class mail
- To agent authorized to accept service of process

Rule 7004(h):

- Service on "insured depository institution"
- Certified mail
- To officer
